Dear Friends,

Happy Christmas and New Year! We are so glad that you've joined us at church over the holiday period. As we celebrate this year's festivities, there is a heaviness in the air as the bushfires continue to devastate vast tracks of land. During such catastrophes we might quickly find ourselves asking "Where is God in all this? Why does he allow such things to happen?" The Bible has a few things to say, two of which are covered in the Bible readings we will hear at church this Christmas season.

Hebrews 2 (Dec 25) tells us that Jesus was made human in every way, entering into our world as one of us. Hebrews makes clear this was to provide atonement for our sins, but it also means he understands the hardships humans endure in a difficult world. John 9 (Dec 29) tells the story of the man born blind. "Was this because of someone's sin?" the disciples ask. Jesus replays by saying *No*, this particular hardship was to provide an opportunity for God to demonstrate his power and grace.

The Bible has more things to say on this topic. Richard Speyer reminded us at last week's 10am service of a couple more: In sending Jesus God shows he does care about his world, and there is coming a day when the world will be made new. But it can be hard in the meantime, can't it? We hope this Christmas is a great reminder that God knows our situation and that he does have a plan even though we might not see or comprehend now.
