 - v2. How is the church sanctified? Who else is Paul addressing, and how are they described?
 - V3-4 How have the Corinthians received grace?
 - What do the above answers have in common?
- 4. How might you define church according to these opening verses (1-4)?
- 5. How does Paul's focus on Jesus challenge (or affirm) your perception of what church is about?
- 6. According to verse 5, what does God do for his people?
- 7. As we read on through verses 6-9, what seems to be the purpose of this enrichment?
- 8. From what we've seen, why is church life worth our commitment?
