Welcome to Waitara Anglican! This week I thought I'd spend a bit of time highlighting a 'behind the scenes' effort that our staff have been implementing over the last few weeks. In recent years, research has highlighted the importance of 'intergenerational ministry'; having different generations within the church family encouraging one another and being encouraged together. This is not to deny the importance of age- and demographic-specific ministries, but rather is an important complement to those ministries that are defined by only one or two characteristics.

So in order to help us help one another, we've done our best to align our Bible teaching this term across as many different age groups as possible. As we hear sermons on 1 Corinthians, our Growth Groups are covering the same material. Our children are learning from 1 Corinthians in C4K at the same time, as are our youth in SWAY (although SWAY and 6:45 generally run one week behind for organisational reasons). The reason for this alignment is to provide opportunities for conversations across the week and across generations, particularly in the family home. If you pick up copies of our Growth Group material, you will see we've included a few questions each week for the whole family. Why not grab a copy and ask a couple of questions on the school run in the morning?

Remember, the Bible tells us to encourage one another, and not simply 'listen to the bloke up the front'!
