



# POM POM OWL

Create your very own pom pom owl – hoot hoot!

## Instructions

1. Print out the owl template (following page) on light card
2. Colour in the front and the back of the owl
3. Cut out the owl (front and back)
4. Cut out the hole in the bottom of the owl (front and back)  
(you may need a parent to help you with this)
5. Line up the front and the back of the owl so the bottom holes line up.
6. Wrap the wool around and around the bottom of the owl going through the hole and underneath the owl and back through the hole. Keep wrapping wool this way until no more can fit through the hole. You may find it easier to cut your wool into 1m lengths and wind the wool in 1m lengths (It stops it getting tangled).
7. When the hole can fit no more wool, take your scissors and slide them between the back and the front of the owl and cut the wool that has been wound through the hole
8. Take a small piece of wool and slide it between the front and the back of the owl, and tie it around the cut wool. Tie it tight and then snip the end off. This will prevent your pom pom from coming undone
9. Fluff out your pom pom and give it a bit of a trim to smooth out any rough edges
10. Glue the front and the back of the owl together and you've done it, a pom pom owl.

## You will need:

- Owl template (following)
- Wool (depending on thickness somewhere between 3-8 m)
- Scissors
- Colouring pencils/pens
- Glue stick
- Google eyes (optional)
