Day 2 - The Great Snake Dilemma

There are four activities for today these are

- 1. Snake mobile
- 2. Juggling balls
- 3. Word snake
- 4. Make your own snakes and ladders



For our youngest kingdom seekers (and possibly the older ones too) 'juggling balls' may require some adult assistance, however snake mobile should be suited to any age group (although assistance may be needed with cutting).

Family activity - snakes and ladders

For those that completed the 'make your own snakes and ladders' activity, why not play it as a family today?

In snakes and ladders you have to 'do it all yourself' – you are either falling down a slippery snake or climbing back up a ladder. The amazing thing about what Jesus did for us on the cross, is that there are no ladders that we have to climb! Rather think of it like a Jesus super rocket that lifts us over whatever Satan and the world can throw at us. Snakes and ladders is a good game to remind ourselves that it isn't by our own strength that we are saved, but through the saving work of Jesus. Even when we feel that we are sliding down snakes in life, we can be sure of Jesus love and saving work.

Family activity 2 - who can juggle the longest?

Did anyone make the juggling balls today? Here is a fun activity for the family. See who can juggle the longest! If, like me, three balls is beyond your skill set, try with two to begin with! It is satisfying to create something isn't it? In the story of creation, God created the world and at the end of each day, he took satisfaction in what he created – he said "it is good!"
