

Micah key ring

God tells us in Micah what is good. He says

“And what does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God.” Micah 6:8

These are great words to remember. This craft will make a key ring that you can put on your bag to help you remember.

Instructions – with shrinky paper

1. Write the words from Micah above out on the shrinky paper. If you have white shrinky paper you may need to use permanent markers (eg sharpies). If you have translucent shrinky paper, see how pencils or coloured felt tip pens will work.
** If you have bought your own shrinky paper please check the back of the packet as the instructions vary **
2. Decorate the page as you like
3. If not already done, trim the corners of the paper so they are rounded (when it shrinks the corners can be sharp)
4. Make a hole in the shrinky paper with a hole punch. Then enlarge this hole by punching an couple more holes either side. This is to make the hole large enough when it shrinks to fit the key ring.
5. NOTE PARENT HELP REQUIRED HERE. Preheat the oven to 150°C. Place your shrinky page on a baking sheet and place in the oven for 1-5 minutes until the shrinking stops and the design lies flat. Remove from oven and allow to cool. **BE CAREFUL IT WILL BE HOT**
6. Once it is cool, clip the shrinky onto the key ring

You will need:

- Key ring
- Page of shrinky plastic
- Depending on the plastic either permanent markers (eg sharpies) or pencils
- Oven
- Baking sheet
- Scissors
- Hole punch



Micah key ring

You will need:

- Key ring
- Lid of a plastic takeaway or icecream container
- Scissors
- Hole punch
- Permanent markers

Instructions – with takeaway container lid

1. Cut out your desired shape from a takeaway container or ice cream lid. Note this can be a bit tricky, so ask a parent to help!
2. Write the words from Micah above and decorate the shape as you like using permanent markers.
3. Make a hole in plastic with a hole punch.
4. Slip the shape onto the key ring
