

Treasure chest


Instructions

1. Cut out the treasure chest template and scrolls
(note – there is some tricky cutting with the clasp on the chest parent assistance may be required)
2. Colour in your chest and scrolls
3. Stick together your treasure chest folding in the tabs and gluing.
4. Roll up your scrolls and tie them with short lengths of ribbon or wool and put them in your treasure chest!

You will need:

- Chest template (following). Works best if printed on light card
- Scissors
- Pencils/coloured pens
- Glue stick
- Treasure scrolls template (following)
Four short pieces of wool or ribbon to tie scrolls
